## Casino workers union opens health center in Atlantic City

Local 54, in a partnership with Continuum Health Alliance, has opened a health center in Atlantic City to serve union members and their families.

Representing about 12,000 workers at 10 casinos, Local 54 is the largest casino workers union in Atlantic City.

The Unite Here health center will provide primary care, physical therapy, chiropractic care and diagnostic services. The cost of creating the center was not immediately available.

Continuum Health Alliance, an ambulatory care services company based in Marlton, N.J., is providing practice management at the site. It hopes to add population health services in the future.

Local 54 self-funds its health insurance benefits for its union members and their dependents, which amount to about 22,000 people.

The union said any cost savings generated by the health center will be returned to their union members after the year is over.
